**Hindu Areas to be reached as pastors combine efforts**

Pastor Samuel writes that he and his LGM churches are making August a month of fasting and prayer. This is in preparation for evangelistic meetings planned in September. The LGM Team will conduct street preaching, tract distributions, and open-air services in new districts and villages. Many



will hear the Gospel for the first time in these meetings conducted in primarily Hindu communities. Pray that many will open their hearts to Christ and pray for the safety of these bold Indian evangelists.

Rick Hutchison is planning a September visit to Ukraine to re-connect with many alumni and friends of the former Kiev Wesley Bible College. He will be preaching in several churches where former KWBC students and faculty serve, as well as exploring new avenues for future ministry for Barnabas Ministries in Ukraine.

Since the Bible college closed in January of 2009, we keep in touch with many alumni through Facebook and other online channels. Many people here in the U.S. ask us about various Ukrainians who visited here over the last several years. Hopefully we can soon give some updates on what God is doing in their lives and ministries.



Our last conference in Ukraine was in 2007. That took place in the Carpathian mountains not far from Uzhgorod. We are hoping to lay ground work for a Kiev conference in 2011. The goal is to draw together as many as possible who share the Wesleyan heritage as taught and embodied by Kiev Wesley Bible College.
